



## **CLIFTON HILL ESTATE**

### **SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT**

Each home should have 3 bins and these should be kept in the court yard *only*.

1. Colour-coded green
2. Colour-coded yellow
3. Colour-coded blue

#### **GREEN BIN** – Lined with Black Bag

This is for 'wet' waste i.e. left-over food, nappies and all messy items.

#### **YELLOW BIN** – Lined with Black Bag

This is for clean paper, newspapers, milk cartons, magazines, plastic bottles and cardboard that will fit into bag. All other cardboard boxes may be placed on the verge ***on the day of collection***. Note Well: Orange bags (when available) may be used for paper

#### **BLUE BIN** – Lined with Black Bag

This is for glass bottles and tins. (*Please do not fill* these bags as they will be too heavy).

**The above bags must be placed on the road verge on THURSDAY's – this being the day of collection.**

Blue bags – these are available at most supermarkets – Pick n Pay, Checkers, Spar, etc. and are used exclusively for weeds and garden cuttings.

*This garden material in any other colour bag will **not** be taken.*

These blue bags must be placed onto the road verge on **THURSDAYS** for collection with other waste.

**BULK GRASS BAGS** – These bags must be used exclusively for **lawn cuttings only**. Please do not fill the bags as the staff will not be able to load it onto the vehicle.

Please ensure your Bulk Grass bags are clearly marked with your Unit Number.

Collection of Bulk Grass Bags – These bags must be placed onto your road verge. Collection is on **MONDAYS** and **FRIDAYS** *only*.

## **DEFINITION OF DIFFERENT CATEGORIES OF WASTE:**

### **WET WASTE**

- (1) Nappies
- (2) All left-over food
- (3) Messy/dirty paper
- (4) Bottle tops
- (5) Milk cartons
- (6) Food wrappers; polystyrene
- (7) All soiled goods

### **GLASS, BOTTLES and TINS**

These may be mixed and placed into a black bag. Please do not overfill the bag. Please ensure tins have been cleaned.

### **ORANGE BAGS (when available) or in Black Bags**

- (1) Clean paper
- (2) Newspaper
- (3) Magazines
- (4) Plastic Shopping packets
- (5) Plastic bottles, clear and white
- (6) Yoghurt containers, cleaned
- (7) Cardboard containers (small, and clean)
- (8) Cardboard boxes (large) – place on verge for collection

### **COOKING OIL**

Please place on verge in a sealed bottle
